<u>October</u>	You should have your supervisor chosen, as well as discussed and selected your topic at a meeting with your supervisor
<u>November</u>	Research notes, preliminary bibliography, preliminary topic and preliminary RQ. Individual timeline. Preparation for the first reflection session.
February	Topic, concepts, arguments, RQ and methodology are discussed. The first formal reflection session.
<u>June</u>	Methodology, arguments, concepts, working and varied bibliography reviewed. Preparation for the interim session. Rough text is ready (e.g. introduction and one or two chapters).
2 DP year	
October	First draft of EE is completed. The interim reflection session.
<u>December</u>	Supervisor's comments on the final version of the EE. Preparation for the submission of the EE.
January-February	Submission of the EE. Preparation for the final reflection session. The final reflection session (Viva voce).

NOTES:

- 1. It is the student's responsibility to find a supervisor, and to ask for appointments. It is never the supervisor's responsibility to look for students, or to suggest meeting times.
- 2. All up-to-date deadlines are given on individual EE report form distributed by EE coordinator (1 DP year).
- 3. EE coordinator is available to students during designated office hours.
- 4. Students must be aware that this is their responsibility to upload the EE to the IBIS system in the final year.

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
