The extended essay (EE)

a 4,000-word essay based on independent research in an area of your personal interest, that will help you to develop academic writing skills, time management and effective communication of ideas.



Creativity, activity, service (CAS)

a component that enables you to pursue your interests and complete a wide variety of projects, extracurriculars and community service.
