Apart from the six selected subjects, you would be additionally required to complete the three DP core elements, namely:

- **Theory of knowledge (TOK)**, an interdisciplinary course in which you will ponder on the nature of knowledge, reflect on different worldviews and develop your critical thinking.
- The extended essay (EE), a 4,000-word essay based on independent research in an area of your personal interest, that will help you to develop academic writing skills, time management and effective communication of ideas.
- **Creativity, activity, service (CAS)**, a component that enables you to pursue your interests and complete a wide variety of projects, extracurriculars and community service.
