In October 2010, there was an earthquake under the Indian Ocean. It measured 7.7 on the Richter Scale. ¹⁾ ____ . That measured 9.1. However, 7.7 is still big and it caused a tsunami. This hit the Mentawai Islands, which are a chain of islands lying about 150 km off the west coast of Sumatra.

²⁾ ____ . Large quakes hit it in 1797 and 1833 and there was another similarly sized earthquake in April 2010. The October earthquake caused a tsunami of about 3 metres – high enough to flood up to 600 metres inland and destroy many villages along the coast. ³⁾ ____ . This was because of bad weather.

A few years earlier a warning system had been installed to help people escape from the flooding. However, as the earthquake was so close to the islands, the tsunami hit them very soon afterwards.

The natural consequence is that we are more prone to viruses and other diseases. There is a simple solution: relax as often as you can. Even a five-minute break, a short walk, listening to a favourite piece of music or taking deep breaths can make a great difference.

(3) _____

If you do not provide your body with the appropriate amounts of proteins, fats, carbohydrates, vitamins and minerals, the immune system will not function properly either. That's why you should include a wide variety of fruit and vegetables in your diet. You can also take vitamin or mineral supplements but consult your doctor first. Care should be taken because in some cases they can raise the risk of infection.

Following the tips, you have a good chance of avoiding many types of illnesses.
